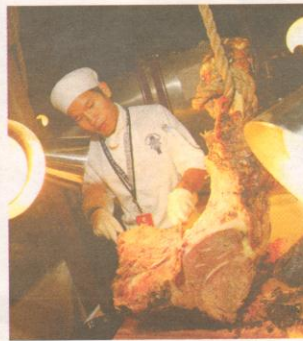
FOOD FOR THOUGHT
