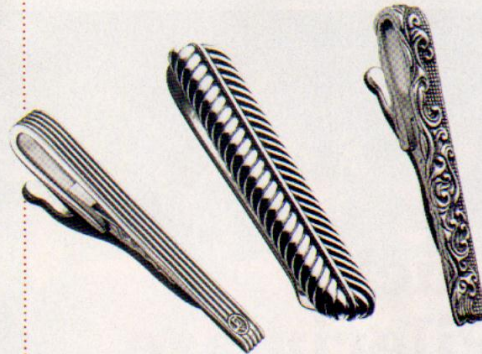
Food for a Cause

Style Tip: Tie Bars

Don Draper style fans rejoice in this season's hottest accessory for men

While tie bars are perfect for putting the finishing touches on any look, they can be a little tricky to pull off. To make sure you are polishing off your look properly, I sat down with Molly Gaddy, boutique manager for David Yurman at The Forum Shops at Caesars, for a little lesson in tie bar etiquette:

Christie Moeller: What is the proper placement of a tie bar?

Molly Gaddy: A tie bar can really go wherever you'd like to wear it, but the ideal placement is just above the third button down from the collar. The tie is a little thinner there, and positioning the bar a bit higher up the shirt will have a slimming effect.

CM: What should one consider when buying one?

MG: Classic, slim tie bars are ageless, but they're still an accessory, so feel free to find one that's fun, like David Yurman's Waves Tie Bar. Sport a dash of color or stones, but stay away from anything overly large or overly embellished. Tie bars should be eye-catching and complementary to the overall outfit, not distracting and overpowering.

Another important consideration is length of the tie bar. The bar should be about three-quarters of the width of your tie, which is enough to hold it down. You don't want the bar to be the same width as the tie.

CM: Any other tie bar wisdom?

MG: Both tie bars and pocket squares are great accessories, but pick one. Sport both at once and you'll look seriously over-accessorized.
